Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They started out as a small machine shop at first hiring four people. Sales for their first year of operation amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and other components. During 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to forty employees and their annual sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Today, Cascade is amongst the leading worldwide makers within the material handling industry.

Manufacture and design of the company's original hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive quest of new business opportunities. During the past sixty years, the material handling trade has matured into a highly advanced area and Cascade has proudly played a part on this progress. Cascade presently continues to develop as the best supplier of forklift attachments and numerous related items. The business feels certain in their capability to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the global market.

During the nineteen fifties, Cascade started to manufacture, design, and advertise its hydraulic attachments. A new facility was made in 1956, to house all of the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which is still the company's current headquarters. Following fifteen years of business, total employees reached one hundred eighty staff and sales had reached almost \$2,300,000.

The next production plant was built in 1959 in Springfield, Ohio. nineteen sixty marked Cascade's initial transfer into the international world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In 1964, the company changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing services throughout the continental USA to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already existing plants in Portland, Oregon and Springfield, Ohio. Cascade products are made globally due to lots of subsidiary operations. In 1994, a brand new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This plant is built to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and the year 1997 with the dramatic acquisition of five corporations, together with the worldwide best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
