

Carriage for Forklift

Carriages and Carriage Parts - Rated by the tine carriage hoisting capability, there are four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for cargo as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads up to 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing utilized for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks can be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted forks can vary by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the tine. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
